Milwaukee man, Green Bay woman race to top honors in annual Fredonia five-mile race

A record total of 169 runners and walkers took to the road for the annual Frebeka 5 on Sunday, June 30, at Waubedonia Park in Fredonia.



The event, which was sponsored by the Fredonia Lions Club, included more than 160 runners who vied for honors in 5-mile, 2-mile and kids' 1-mile races.

A 2-mile walk was also held.

Kyle Fraser of Milwaukee was the overall winner of the 5-mile run. He completed the course in 29 minutes, 14 seconds.

Fraser was also the overall winner of the 2-mile run (10:30).

The top female finisher in the 5-mile race was Jennifer Chaudoir of Green Bay, who was clocked in 32:49.

Chaudoir also won the women's title in the 2-mile run (12:26).

Proceeds from the Frebeka 5 benefit Starting Point of Ozaukee, the T-Baum Foundation, Blind Outdoor Leisure Development and Lions Club projects.
