# Grafton resident leads the pack at fourth annual Port Washington triathlon

Dozens of athletes put their speed and endurance to the test during the fourth annual City of

Seven Hills Triathlon in Port Washington last Saturday.



Adan Burgos of Grafton emerged as the overall winner of the competition, which included a 2/10ths of a mile swim in Pirates' Hollow Waterpark, followed by a 12-mile bike ride and 3-mile run on city streets.

Burgos, who was the top finisher among males ages 30 to 39, posted a cumulative time of 1 hour, 19 seconds, including transition periods between events.

The top female finisher was Andi Barber of Port Washington (1:12:23).

The winning team was Mike & Lily Relay, consisting of Mike Peacy and Lily Kaplan of Grafton. Their collaborative time was 1:09:16.

A total of 37 individuals and four relays participated in this year's event, which was organized by the city's Parks and Recreation Department.
